

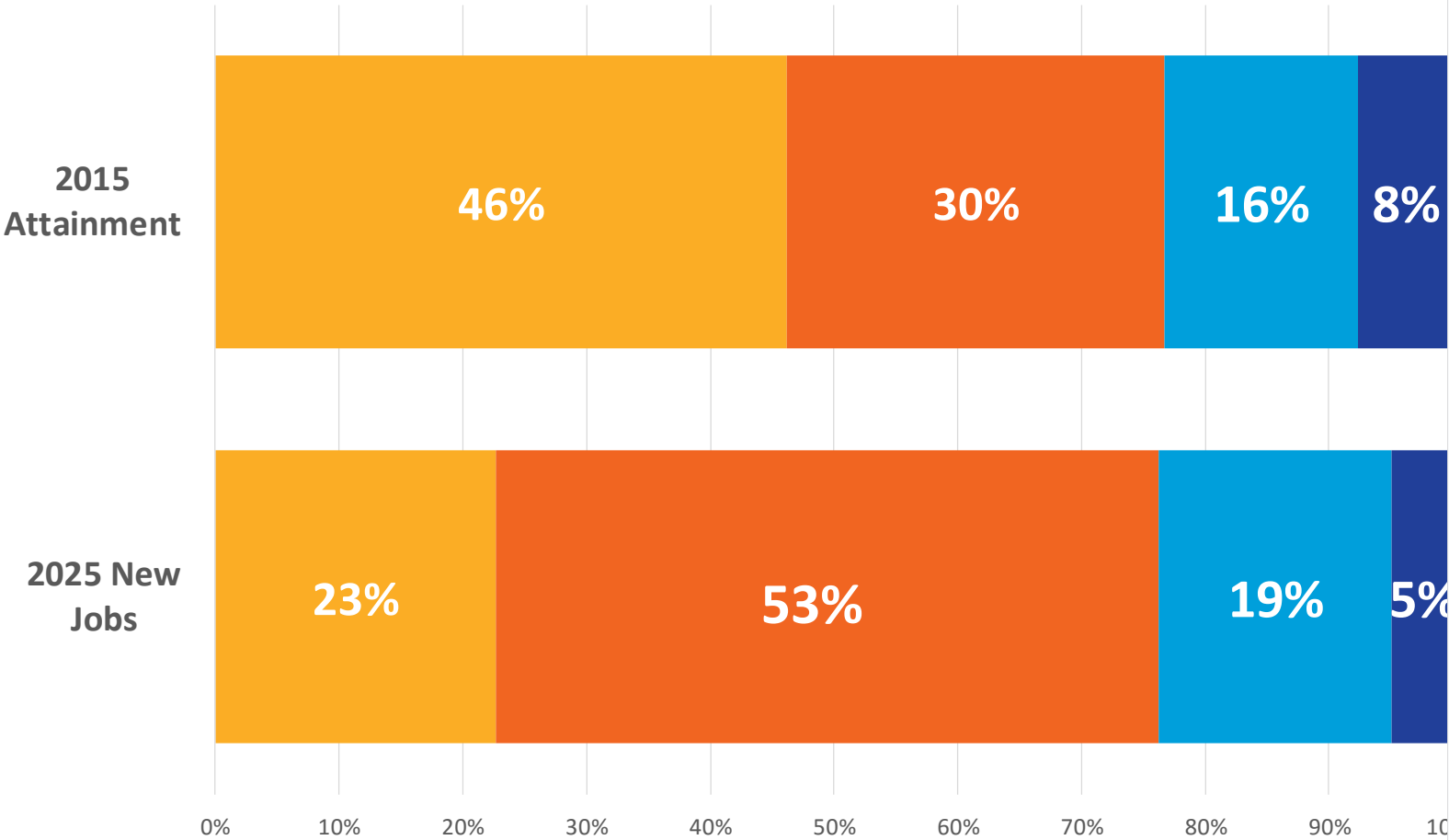

Increase the per capita personal income as a percentage of the national average from 93.51% in 2013 to 98.20% by 2017.

MEDIAN HOUSEHOLD INCOME

TODAY **45,690**
dollars

Increase the state median household income from \$45,690 in 2013 to \$51,424 by 2017.

INCOME POVERTY RATE

TODAY **16.8**
percent

Decrease the state income poverty rate from 16.8% in 2013 to 15.3% by 2017.
