RE: State Performance Negotiations

Following a review of the statistical adjustment model predicated outcomes, economic and performance data supporting the proposed performance targets, and subsequent discussions with the Department of Labor Region IV Office, the Oklahoma Office of Workforce Development and the Oklahoma Employment Security Commission finalized the Program Year (PY) 2016 and PY 2017 Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) and Wagner-Peyser (WP) performance targets.
