**RE:** Notice of Award for PY16/FY17

Last week, the U.S. Department of Labor Education and Training Administration informed the Oklahoma Office of Workforce Development (OOWD) of a small rescission to WIOA Adult and Dislocated Worker fund amounts contained in the continuing resolution budget passed recently. Today, OOWD received the Notice of Award confirming the rescission of .496%. The impact on Oklahoma is below.

### **Adult:**

Initial PY16/FY17 Allotment: \$6,320,826  
Revised with Reduction: \$6,293,377  
Difference: (\$27,449)

### **Dislocated Worker:**

Initial PY16/FY17 Allotment: \$5,376,760  
Revised with Reduction: \$5,354,229  
Difference: (\$22,531)

In order to prevent further fiscal impacts to the local areas, OOWD will absorb the cut at the state level. Local areas will not see any reduction in funds from the planning numbers issued in May 2016.
