**RE:** Estimated Local Area Allocations for PY18 and FY19 WIOA Title I Youth, Adult, and Dislocated Worker Programs

On March 23, 2018 the United States Department of Labor, Employment and Training Administration (DOLETA) issued Training and Employment Guidance Letter (TEGL) No. 13-17 providing states with planning estimates for Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Youth, Adult, and Dislocated Worker program allotments. This release allows the Oklahoma Office of Workforce Development (OOWD) to calculate estimated local area allocations then release the calculated estimates prior to the receipt of the Notice of Award.

To determine the estimated local area allocations OOWD first calculates the 85% minimum pass-through amount for the Youth and Adult allotments, and the 60% minimum pass-through amount for the Dislocated Worker allotment. The appropriate formula, as described and approved by DOLETA in the WIOA State Plan for The State of Oklahoma, to pass-through amount for each WIOA program. The state plan is found online at [www.oklahomaworks.gov](http://www.oklahomaworks.gov).

The following allocations are estimates to be used for planning purposes only, with the knowledge and understanding that updated planning numbers and awards will be released when final allotments are provided to the state.
